WELCOME

Welcome to Webelos Trail to Eagle, we are glad you are joining us for the 2020 adventure. Webelos Trail to Eagle is for Webelos to learn what Scouting BSA is all about. Webelos will participate in activities with Troops, Ships and Crews that will focus on the patrol method, scout run units, how parents can support Scouts BSA and to work on Arrow of Light rank requirement adventures. We include a wide variety of presentations encompassing many points of the Webelos requirements counting toward Webelos and Arrow of Light rank advancement.

REGISTRATION

Participation in the Webelos Trail to Eagle event is open to all Webelos (4th and 5th grade [AOL scouts]). Registration by Pack/Den is encouraged though individual registration will be accepted. **All registrations must be made in advance of November 19.** Registration is online using the Council website: <https://mycouncil.alamoareabsa.org/Event/10720>

The online registration fee is \$15 per scout and covers all materials needed for the event.

Webelos Trail to Eagle will be a rain-or-shine event so please come prepared with the Cub Scout Six Essentials or the Boy Scout Ten Essentials, including a FILLED WATER BOTTLE.

REFUNDS will only be issued if the Trail to Eagle is canceled by Alamo Area Council.

Siblings and/or friends are not allowed at the Train to Eagle



EVENTS AND SCHEDULE

The camp entrance will open at 8:15AM Saturday morning. **Scouts should arrive in uniform and mask are required for everyone at all times..** Upon arrival, please enter in the Cub Country Gate on Wedgewood Dr. Parking will be in the grassy field to the left. Walk down the road to the McGimsey House (White House) to check in and prescreening. Each participant must have Health Form A&B and the Camp Participant COVID-19 "At Risk" Statement.

Registration will open for check-in at 8:30AM and proceed until 9:00AM in the **McGimsey House Picnic Area**. We will have our opening ceremony at 9:00am at the McGimsey house flag poles.

On Saturday each participating Troop/Unit will demonstrate or teach an activity or skill to the Webelos while the adults have an opportunity to visit with the youth and adult leadership of each Troop/Unit. This event will have Troops/Unit demonstrations from all around the Alamo Area Council so be sure to ask questions. I.e.: when/where/time the unit meets weekly, camping.

Webelos do not need to stay for the whole day. Once they are ready to leave, please check out with staff at the McGimsey House before leaving the park.
