CIMARRON DISTRICT AWARDS

There are several ways to recognize exceptional scouters for the work they do in Scouting at the District and Unit level. These scouters will be recognized at the Cimarron District Banquet on January 24, 2015. Nominations for these awards must be submitted no later than January 8, 2015.

- 1. <u>Cimarron Trail Unit Award</u> Many Scouters (Pack, Troop, Post or Crew Adult leader) have a tremendous impact upon Scouting in their neighborhood but may not be well known throughout the District. Their work is very important and directly affects the quality of Scouting in our District. A unit member (Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Committee Chairman, Committee Member, Den Leader, etc.) who has gone above and beyond what is normally expected of their position is the type of person we are looking for. This award is an attempt to properly recognize individuals who have excelled in serving boys on a unit level. This award may be earned only once while a member of Cimarron District. More than one member of a unit may be nominated during the same year. To nominate a scouter for the Cimarron District Unit Award, please use the attached form. Nomination for this award should be confidential. Scouters nominated for the Cimarron District Outstanding Leader of the Year will automatically be considered for this award, provided they have not already earned the award.
- 2. <u>Cimarron District Outstanding Leader of the Year</u> This award is designed to recognize the top Cubmaster, Cub Scout Leader, Scoutmaster, Boy Scout Leader, Venture Crew Chief or Venture Crew Leader of Cimarron District. This person can be nominated by any member of the unit (parent or registered leader) or the district who is knowledgeable about the person's Scouting record. One scouter will be recognized for each category among all of the nominations that are submitted. To nominate a scouter for the Cimarron District Outstanding Leader of the Year, please use the attached form. A scouter may earn this award more than once.
- 3. <u>District Award of Merit</u> This award is used to recognize scouters who have performed exceptional service to the district. For more information about the District Award of Merit or to nominate a scouter for the District Award of Merit, please see the attached District Award of Merit Nomination Form.

Nomination for each of these awards above should be kept confidential and recipients will be recognized at the District Banquet.

A unit member (Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Committee Chairman, Committee Member, Den Leader, etc.) who has gone above and beyond what is normally expected of their position is the type of person we are looking for (a den leader who ,as coordinated several pack functions, a den leader who followed a group of boys from Tiger Cubs to Webelos, a Cubmaster who has reenergized the pack, an Assistant Scoutmaster who has attending the majority of the campouts that ensured that the troop was able to go camping, a committee member who has participated in many different aspects of the committee – always willing to step forward and help whenever or wherever needed are some good examples). <u>This person can be nominated by **any** member of the unit (parent or registered leader) or the district who is knowledgeable about the person's Scouting record</u>. Note: This award is for service within a unit. Scouters who perform exemplary service to the district are recognized by the District Award of Merit. Scouters nominated for the Cimarron District Outstanding Leader of the Year Award will automatically be considered for this award provided they have not already earn this award.

<u>**Cimarron District Outstanding Leader of the Year Award**</u> – This award is designed to recognize the top Cubmaster, Cub Scout Leader, Scoutmaster, Boy Scout Leader, Venture Crew Chief or Venture Crew Leader of Cimarron District. This person can be nominated by any member of the unit (parent or registered leader) or the district who is knowledgeable about the person's Scouting record. Scouters who have earned this award in previous years are eligible to earn this award more than once. One scouter will be recognized from each category among all of the nominations that are submitted.</u>

Nominees must be currently registered in Scouting and have completed the training appropriate to their position.
