



SALSA Mentoring Program - Nov. 3rd @ MBU

What am I going to do with my life?

At this fall's MBU the San Antonio League of Scouting Alumni will present a career mentoring program for youth looking to answer that question. Attendees must be at least 15 years old.

For this program we will focus on three areas 1) Legal Professions 2) Health Professions and 3) Vocational & Technical Fields.

After a 45-minute general session for each area the groups will split up into smaller groups to get more individual attention and allow scouts to get more detailed in their questions.

Legal Professions mentoring session: The program will talk about why the law is a good career, what are some of the things people do with a law degree, how people prepare to enter law school. We will have litigators, Patent Attorneys, corporate attorneys, and oil and gas attorneys to share their perspective.

Health Professions mentoring session: In this session we will discuss the wide variety of careers that fall under the category of Health Professions. Including nurses, doctors, nurse practitioners, physicians' assistants. We will touch on why you might select one avenue over the other and how to get started on that path.

Vocational & Technical Fields mentoring session: There is a shortage of skilled labor is Texas and with the push to rebuild the country's infrastructure there is going to be even more demand for carpenters, plumbers, welders, electricians, HVAC techs and the like. How do you get into these fields? What is a plumber's life like? Spend some time with one and hear their stories and have your questions answered.
